WELCOME TO THE LIED CENTER FOR PERFORMING ARTS



Walk to the main entrance. Ushers will greet you and ask to scan your mobile or printed ticket.

Once your ticket is scanned, you will walk forward and wait until a staff member asks you to walk through a security scanner.





Next, you will walk through the main lobby and be handed a playbill by one of our hospitality staff members.



On the way to your seat you may attend a pre-talk in the Steinhart room or pick up concessions.

You can also drop your jacket off at coat check. Sensory kits are available here for check out.





When you are ready to find your seat, please look for the door number on your ticket. This door number is the entrance you will take into the theatre.



Ushers will help you to your seat. Once it is almost showtime, the lights will start to dim.

Once the show starts, the house lights will turn off. Aisle lights will remain on to lights up the floors in case you need to exit the theatre.





There may be talking, singing, or dancing depending on the performance. Some people may laugh or clap.



If noise is an issue, the sensory kit contains earplugs and headphones.

At intermission, the house lights will come back on. There will be time to use the bathroom and get concessions.





When the show is over, there may be a crowd as you are trying to exit. You may stay in your seat until the crowd thins out if that is more comfortable for you.
